

How to make a booking in 6 simple steps

Step One - Check the availability of the tour.

Step Two - Suitability of the holiday.

Please note some tours can be demanding with several hotels being used, please read the details carefully before deciding that the tour is suitable for you. If you are unsure please contact the office where we will do our best to advise you.

Step Three - Pay a deposit.

(Cheques made payable to KM Travel of Chesterfield)

Step Four - We post back to you.

By return of post we will send you your receipt of payments & booking form, which you should check all the details are correct.

(Please be aware this is your responsibility to check, if any of the information is wrong please contact us immediately)

Alternatively call into our shop, there we can complete the booking procedure as you wait.

Step Five - Pay your final balance.

Balances are due six weeks prior to departure for British Holidays and ten weeks prior to departure for Ireland and European holidays

Step Six - Luggage labels & Itinerary.

Seven to ten days prior to departure you will receive your luggage labels & itinerary with taxi times*
(* subject to area)

TRAVEL INSURANCE

From 1st January 2009 the sale of Travel Insurance became regulated by the Financial Authority. As we do not hold the necessary authorisation, we are no longer able to offer or advise on Travel Insurance matters, therefore you will have to make alternative arrangements. Travel insurance is available at many outlets for you convenience.

WE STRONGLY ADVISE ALL CLIENTS TAKE OUT TRAVEL INSURANCE

It is not compulsory in UK law to take out travel insurance for a tour within the UK, but it is compulsory for tours operating outside the UK. You will be required to provide us with your policy details and emergency contact when travelling to Europe, Republic of Ireland and Isle of Man. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause but the new regulations have made the selling of Travel Insurance more difficult and expensive to operate.

Holiday Cost & Surcharges

If the price of the holiday is reduced prior to departure, you will only have to pay the final price.

As a company we aim to provide great value holidays and we do not believe in the practice of surcharges or hidden costs.

However with our prices being organised so far in advance unforeseen rising costs (fuel, hotels and the strength of the pound to the euro) may have to be accounted for.

Our promise to you is only to apply a surcharge when we have no other option.

On our part we have the obligation to provide you with the holiday you have booked. Our specification of that holiday and our terms are clearly stated in the brochure. Your contract is entered into with KM Travel of Chesterfield. This Booking Agreement applies to all holidays sold from this brochure. Your holiday contract is subject to English law and jurisdiction.

2. YOU PAY THE BALANCE

The balance of your holiday cost must be paid via the office at which you made your booking not later than 6 weeks before the departure date (10 weeks before on tours to Ireland & Europe) If you book within the applicable balance due period you must pay the full holiday cost at the time of booking. If the balance is not paid in time we reserve the right to cancel your holiday, retain your deposit and apply cancellation charges set out in paragraph 4 (if you cancel your holiday)

3. IF YOU CHANGE YOUR BOOKING

If you wish to change your booking to another departure date in the 2026 brochure we shall do our utmost to make the changes, provided written notification is received from the person who signed the booking form, not later than 12 weeks before your departure date. This must be accompanied by a payment of £10.00 to cover administration cost. Any alteration made later than the original balance due date will be treated as a cancellation and will be subject to the cancellation charges set out below.

4. IF YOU CANCEL YOUR HOLIDAY

You may cancel your holiday at any time provided that the cancellation is made by the person signing the booking form, and is communicated in writing to ourselves. As this incurs administration costs we shall retain your deposit and in addition, apply cancellation charges set out below :

7. CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE

8. RIGHT OF REFUSAL

We must point out that KM Travel of Chesterfield reserve the unconditional right to refuse a booking or terminate a passenger's holiday in the event of unreasonable conduct which in our opinion is likely to cause distress, damage, danger or annoyance to other customers, employees, property or to any third party. This includes any passenger who fails to advise us of any medical condition or disability in accordance with paragraph 9 (below). If you are prevented from travelling as a result of such termination, our responsibility for your holiday thereupon ceases. Full cancellation charges will apply and we will be under no obligation whatsoever for any refund, compensation or loss you may incur.

9. PEOPLE WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

We accept bookings from people with special needs. However, any disability must be highlighted at the time of booking. 3. IF WE CHANGE YOUR HOLIDAY

The contents of this brochure are correct at the time of going to press. We reserve the right to make changes to the information contained in this brochure and will advise you of any changes affecting your holiday where those changes occur prior to booking. The arrangements for holidays in this brochure may require changes after a booking is made. Most of these changes are very minor but where they are significant we will notify you as soon as reasonably possible before your departure date. A 'significant change' is one that involves changing your departure date, resort area, town of departure, reducing the quality of your main hotel. Changing the location of any hotel does not constitute a 'significant change'. In the event of a 'significant change' you may decide to (a) continue with the amended holiday (b) accept an alternative holiday which we may offer to you or (c) cancel your booking.

Whilst we have no direct control over the provision of these services to you by suppliers we will pay to our clients the equivalent of such damages as they would be entitled to receive under English law in an English court for any personal injury to the client including illness or death, caused by the failure to perform or the improper performance of such services by our employees or any of our suppliers contracted or sub-contracted by us to provide any part of the arrangements for your holiday as described in this brochure where such failure or improper performance is due to the fault of such person (and providing it is not due to an act or omission of the person affected or that of a third party not connected with the provision of your holiday) and not an event which such person could not foresee or forestall even if they had taken all due care.
